

Geography

Research - Look at where in the world rainforests are with the [FreeFest](#). Use maps and atlases and look at the landscape of rainforests.

Look at the different habitats the animals in the jungle might live in. If you can create a few of the habitats in the playground and get the children to place the animals in the correct habitats.

Mathematics

Shape - create the animals from the book with different shapes. E.g. for the lion use a parallelogram for the body, for the head, and for the profile use different size rectangles and squares.

Addition - using the number of legs on the different animals, get the children to create their own calculations. Use their pictures of animals and numbers and get them to create their own calculations in their books. Use the [jungle and rainforest themed number lines](#) to assist in counting on.

Data handling - gorillas jump really high. Measure the height the children each jump, record the data collected in a graph.

Music

Create rain sounds using their raincoats.
Create a piece of music that reflects their interpretation of rainforest sounds. This could include use of voice, drums or using objects they can find in the classroom.



English

Poetry - Read the poems to the children without telling them which animal they are about and see if they can guess which animal it is describing. They can then go off and do independent work and they have to do the same task but through making the poems themselves.

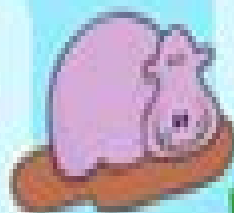
There is a class choice a couple of poems they like the best and maybe add another few lines. Do this as guided writing in groups, making to create an extension of a poem in the book already. These [Rumble in the Jungle themed page headers](#) would be useful to use.

On research and find a new animal you might find in the Jungle, it could be an exotic insect or bird. Create a new poem that could be added to the book.

Letter writing - after writing the new poem for the book, write a letter to the author asking if they would add it to their book.

Hot seating - choose different children to be different animals and sit them in the middle of the circle. The children can be as creative as they want in their answers and their questions.

Role Play - use these lovely [jungle masks](#) for the children to enhance their creativity and imagination. This could be part of a drama session in which the children take on the roles of the different jungle animals.

Science

The rainforest - investigate the different animals that live in the rainforest. Two circles on a page, stick the animals from the jungle in one circle and ones from England in the other.

On investigation of different animals, mammals, reptiles, birds etc. Investigate materials that would make the best rain coat in a rainforest.

Art and Design

Create a rain stick using kitchen roll tubes, paper, rubber bands and decorations. It relates to investigation on what material makes the best rain sound, what could the tube.

Create trees and bushes with tissue paper, tissue paper and kitchen roll tubes. Use these as a setting for [Rumble in the Jungle](#) books and pictures. The children to bring in soft toys to add to the setting. Then the stories the children could explore shadows through the leaves and different shades of green.
