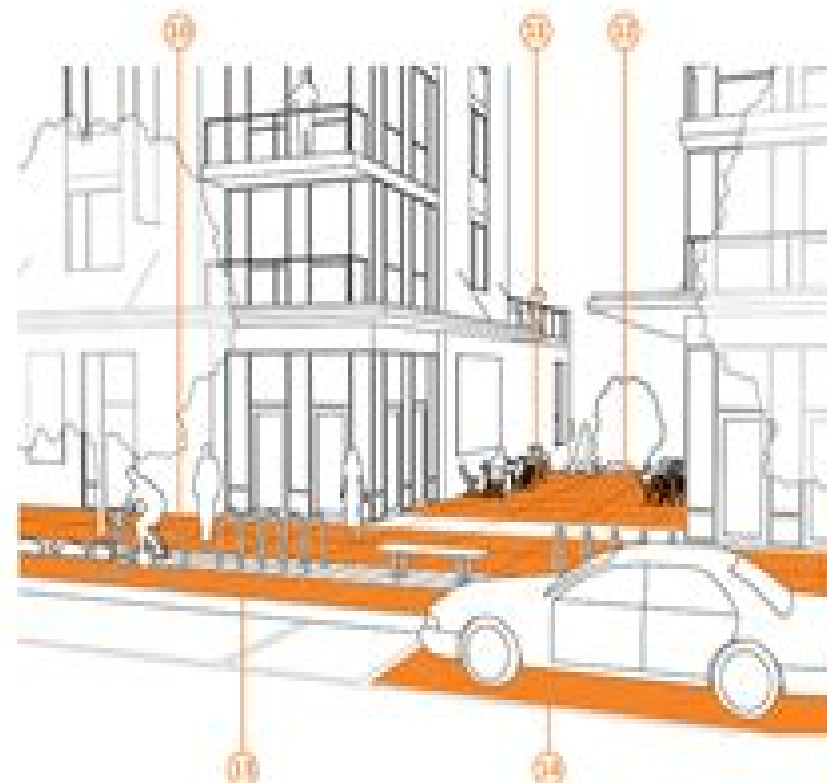




## ELEMENTS

- 1. BUILDING SETBACK**  
A row of structures and/or features parallel to adjacent height and density is used to visually connect urban lots.
- 2. BUILDING FRAMING**  
Structural parking is located in grade underneath a building, is elevated well below the primary framing, and maintains visual interest through the use of screening and decorative publicly accessible uses such as retail and office space. Public parking structures naturally ventilated and visually connected from view with parking, pedestrian circulation, or transit.
- 3. BELOW-GRADE PARKING**  
Below-grade parking is parking located underground where possible. Below-grade parking should be visually screened, and excavations that are visible above grade should be clad in high-quality materials.

- 4. STRUCTURED PARKING**  
Structured parking should be located in the center of blocks or at the rear when not directly abutting adjacent properties. Ideally, they should be visually screened by screening other uses around them, providing a screen where this is not feasible, parking structures should be elevated and high quality materials and landscaping vegetation.
- 5. LANDSCAPE SCREEN**  
Landscaping structures should be located in a way to be visible from the primary public way. They should be visually screened using screening, high quality fencing and/or vegetation.
- 6. RETAIL SCREEN**  
All developments must include visually located signage such as signs accessible from the public way or an illuminated, graphic, and screen like design that connects with the "look-alike" design language of the surrounding context and scale.
- 7. CURB CUTS + AVENUE**  
Curb cuts and avenue cuts from parking lots and structures that cross the sidewalk. They should address pedestrian and public safety and located in a way to minimize traffic noise.
