The temperatures are usually mild, and there is a good amount of rainfull throughout the year. The plants and animals in temperate climates are adapted to the changing seasons.

There is also a climate called a desert climate. Deserts are usually very bot during the day and cold at night. They receive very little rainfall, so plants and animals in-deserts have to be able to satisfie with very little water.

Polar climates are found near the North and South Foles. These areas are very cold and snowy most of the year. The plants and animals that live in polar climates have thick for or blobbor to keep them warm.

Some places have a climate called a Mediterraneon climate. These areas have hot, dry summers and mild, wet winters. Places like California and parts of Australia have a Mediterraneon climate.
