Type 1 diabetes is a condition in which a person's body cannot produce enough insulin to keep blood sugar levels under control.

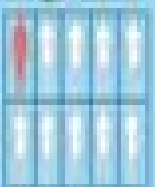


How common is it?

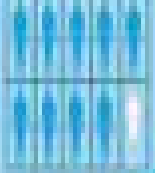
The number of people with Type 1 diabetes has risen sharply in recent years. It is now the most common form of diabetes in children and young people.

According to Diabetes UK:

Around 10% of people in the UK with diabetes have Type 1 diabetes.



Around 10,000 children in the UK have diabetes. 90% of these children have Type 1 diabetes.



How is it treated?

Type 1 diabetes is treated by providing the body with insulin through injections or an insulin pump. The body's blood sugar levels need to be carefully monitored, with blood sugar tests being a key part of a continuous glucose monitor (CGM).



Approximately 80% of people with Type 1 diabetes live in the UK.

Around 10% of people with Type 1 diabetes are aged 18 or under.

A person with Type 1 diabetes must take insulin every day to survive.

What causes it?

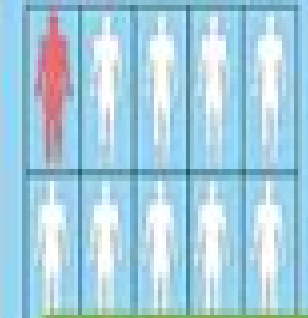
For people with type 1 diabetes, the body's immune system attacks and destroys the cells that produce the hormone insulin. Insulin is responsible for controlling blood glucose levels.
