Many companies are now offering their employees sabbaticals in an attempt to retain valuable staff. Due to highlypressurised work environments and being constantly connected to work via technology, many staff are stressed and tired, leading to illness or dissatisfaction. Ensuring that staff have effective downtime is just as important as meeting work targets. Sabbaticals are one way of getting employees to stay with a company, but if they have to stay in a pressured environment for five years before they qualify for a sabbatical, then the effectiveness of a sabbatical can be extremely limited.

One company thought the answer to retaining experienced staff was to introduce a sabbatical programme, but it was unsuccessful. The company offered excellent training for new mangers and engineers, but over 50 percent left once they had completed their training surprisingly, although salaries were not as competitive as those of rival companies, they were not the main issue. During staff exit interviews, they indicated that the main problem was that there were no clear career development paths. In fact, some older staff had been in the same position for twenty years.
