

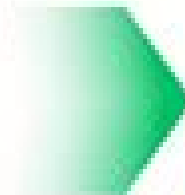

Crawling



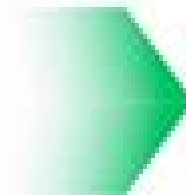
Google Crawlers download text, images, and videos from pages it found on the internet.
