Test of Sensory Functions in Infants (TSFI) - A criterion-referenced test for children 4 to 18 months of age measuring sensory processing and reactivity according to five sub-domains: reactivity to tactile deep pressure, adaptive motor functions, visual-tactile integration, ocular-motor control, and reactivity to vestibular stimulation.

Test of Visual-Perceptual Skills (non-motor) (TVPS) - A standardized test for children 4 years to 12 years 11 months of age, used to determine visual perception strengths and weaknesses, without requiring a written or manipulative response.
